This week our students got to participate in an assembly held by the Dairy Council of California. Their interactive, mobile farm classroom arrived on the playground carrying two very special guests: a cow and a calf!

Through a live milking demonstration, our students learned how milk and dairy foods are produced, and how they contribute to healthy eating.

They also learned the anatomy of a cow and how farmers across our State take care of cows to produce milk for thousands of people. Ask your child how many stomachs a cow has? The answer may surprise you!

Students also got to meet Oreo, a 1 month old calf and were excited to have the opportunity to pet her. Thank you to the Dairy Council of California for bringing a little bit of farm life to our city kids!

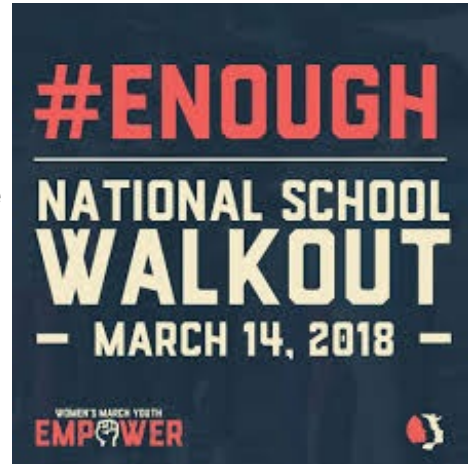

and how to talk to your children about the Parkland School Tragedy

LFCSA would like to show solidarity with schools across the country who will be walking out of their classrooms for 17 minutes, to honor the students and staff who lost their lives in Parkland, Florida last month.

We understand this is a difficult conversation for parents and teachers to have with children and we want to make sure the conversation is age appropriate. For this reason our school is working with our teachers and School Site Council to organize a walk out that does not focus on the tragedy but instead focuses on sending the message of our school's core value: "You are my Other Me" and we believe we can work together to make sure all schools are a safe place for all children.

Information: Research Study on Arts Integrated Learning at LFCSA

Hello LFCSA Parents!

My name is Amarpal Khanna and I'm doing doctoral studies at Loyola Marymount University. As a former two-term board member of Los Feliz Charter School for the Arts and an arts educator, I believe that the LFCSA's approach to learning is unique, special, and worthy of documenting the important work our community is doing. To document the work, I'm preparing a research study on the arts integrated curriculum at Los Feliz Charter School for the Arts. You are invited to be a part of the study. Part of the study involves specifically 4th and 5th grade Latino and African American students, however other parts of the study will include ALL 4th and 5th grade students who choose to participate. Other participants in the study include 4th and 5th grade teachers, art teachers, and 4th and 5th grade parents.

Participation involves the following: a 45-60 min. parent interview, a 30-45 min. student interview, and observation of participating students working on an arts integrated class project and observation of participating students

in their arts specialist class. The interviews will be either afterschool or on a scheduled weekend. The data collected will be included in the narrative of the experience of students at LFCSA learning through arts integration. The final study is a dissertation that will be published in research journals. The LFCSA learning approach has an opportunity to be documented! Your consent to participate is needed, and permission forms are [attached here](#) for review. Respond by Sunday March 4th!
