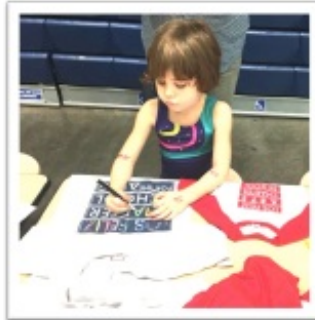

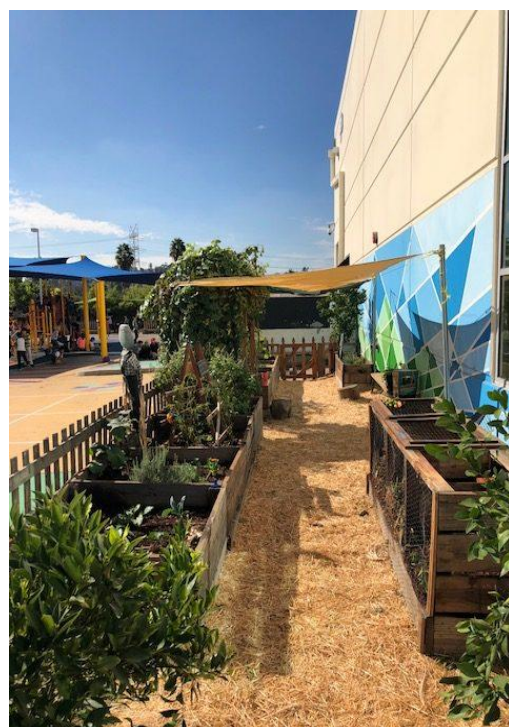
Join us on for a cocktail party benefitting our lovely Garden Fundraiser for the LFCSA Garden Program.
