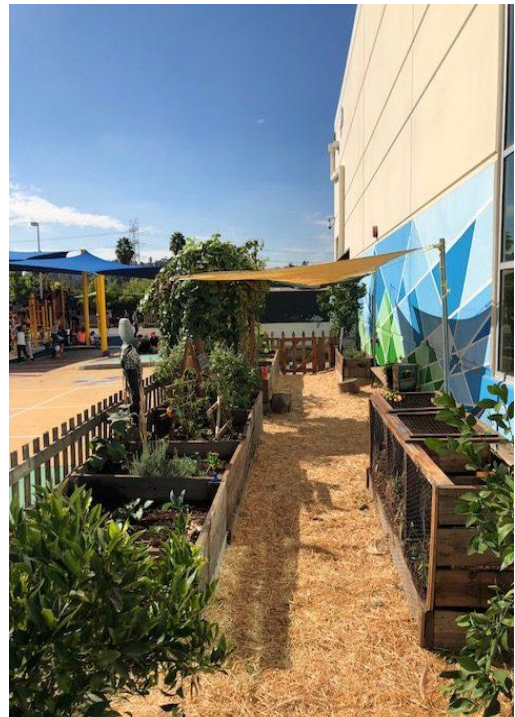

Information: Expansion and Co-location Update

We were excited to meet many of our new LFCSA families at our recent orientation. We recognized some faces of current families who have new siblings starting with us, we look forward to having the younger ones join the LFCSA family. We do have some spots available in our Middle School and registration is still happening in all other grades. Please spread the word about LFCSA! Please encourage interested folks to apply and not be discouraged by the waitlists.

This week, Dr. Lee had a brief opportunity to introduce herself to the Principal of Albion Elementary during a Prop 39 District meeting. They discussed a meeting to begin negotiating the details of co-locating. That meeting will take place at the end of May. Once this meeting happens we will update the community and announce a timeline for the relocation.

Dr. Lee also had the opportunity to meet with our current TK families and discuss the pros and cons of relocating to the co-location. After these meetings the administration decided to allow this group of students to remain at the Media Center location. They will be the ONLY Kindergarten class at the Media Center location.

Once we confirm the number of spots available in this Kindergarten class we will invite all incoming Kindergarten families who would like a spot in this class to place their child in a lottery for the available spots. More information about this lottery and instructions on how to enter will be released the first week of June.

Here is the updated chart of which grades will be at each location:

Co-location	TK, K*	TK, K & 1st grade	TK, K & 1st grade
Media Center location	1st - 6th*	2nd - 7th	2nd - 8th

*exception: one K class to remain at Media Center location next year and future years.
